<p style="text-align: center;">WHAT INFORMATION DO WE COLLECT, MAINTAIN, AND COMMUNICATE?</p>	<p>TJIM collects and maintains your personal information so we can provide investment management services to you. The types and categories of information we collect and maintain about you include:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Information we receive from you to open an account (social security number, home and/or work address, telephone number, fax number, and email), to establish that our services are suitable given your situation, requirements, and expectations (income, assets, investment objectives, risk tolerance, investment preferences), or to provide investment advice to you; • information that we generate to service your account (such as trade tickets and account statements); or • information that we may receive from third parties with respect to your account (such as trade confirmations from brokerage firms, account statements from custodians, and suitability documentation supplied by the financial consultant). <p>TJIM will not disclose any personal information about you or your account(s) unless one of the following conditions is met:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • We receive your prior written consent; • we believe the recipient is your authorized representative; or • we are permitted by law to disclose information to the recipient.
<p style="text-align: center;">HOW WE PROTECT YOUR PERSONAL INFORMATION</p>	<p>To fulfill our privacy commitment at TJIM, we have instituted firm-wide practices to safeguard the information that we maintain about you.
